- If older age or health are a concern, we may not perform surgery if we feel they are not a good surgical candidate.
- Flea prevention may automatically be applied if your pet has heavy flea infestation at cost to you.

Enlarged Uterus Fee (EUF)

Can be result of a dog that is pregnant, in-heat, overweight, had multiple litters, or has mild infection.

Under 50 lbs \$30
Over 50 lbs \$60

Pyometra _____ Variable

Severe infection of uterus. Price is a discretion of veterinarian.

Different Anesthetic Fee _____ \$10

Brachycephalic Breeds (Boxers, Boxer mixes), pets 7 yrs and older, cardiac patients

Extra Suture Fee (As needed basis) _____ \$10

For obese or in-heat dogs, that require additional suture material

Cryptorchid _____ Cost of neuter + full price of spay

Testicles have not fully descended for male dog/cat

Additional fees may apply for: IV fluids, antibiotics, anesthesia time, pain medication

No Proof of Rabies Vaccine _____ \$14

If a pet does not have written proof (Rabies Certificate on paper, not tags) of a current Rabies vaccine, it will be given on the day of surgery

Umbilical Hernia _____ \$20

Dewclaw Removal for Dogs (Rear side only) _____ \$30 per side

Fractious Animal Fee (Difficult to handle/restrain) _____ \$30

Already Spayed _____ \$15

- If a female dog or cat is found to be already spayed during surgery, the regular surgery fee will apply
- If a female dog or cat is found to be spayed (or has a reaction) after sedation
